

JUNIOR LEADERSHIP SCHOOL

Description: The three training pillars of the Young Marines Program are teaching self-discipline, team building, and Leadership development. The Junior Leadership School (JLS) is the most junior leadership school in the Young Marine Program. It is designed to help the Junior Young Marine Corporals and mature Basic Young Marine Lance Corporals develop interpersonal and leadership skills. Upon completion of this school, the Young Marine graduate should have a working knowledge of the nine performance objectives in the Junior Guide book:

Qualifications:

Minimum age: 11 years old (at start of school)

Maximum age: None

Minimum rank: 11/12 year olds, YM/CPL with a date of rank on or before 1 October 2007
13 & older, YM/LCPL with a date of rank on or before 1 October 2007

Minimum TIP: 1 year on or before 1 April 2008

PFT/HFT Classification: 3rd Class (database must be up to date with all quarterly scores)

Other: Member in good standing

Participated in two overnight unit activities **without incident.**

Mature enough to travel alone

Application Fee: \$300.00. Additional costs may be charged at the ticket counter for unaccompanied minor fees imposed by the airlines. National Headquarters is not responsible for these charges.

Discounted Fee: None

Applications: Apply through the Young Marines database only beginning 4 January 2008.

Unit Restrictions: Units are restricted to 2 Young Marines in JLS until the application restrictions are lifted on 25 January 2008. Additional registrations submitted to National Headquarters over the restricted number prior to 25 January 2008 will result in all registrations being denied. National Headquarters will not choose two for you.
